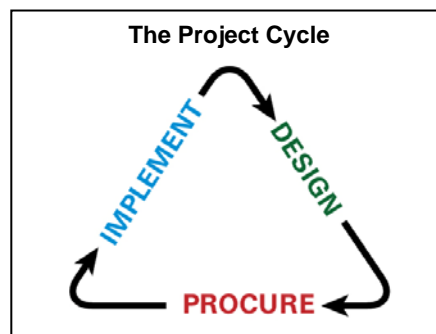


Course Overview:

The purpose of the course is to increase competency and operational awareness on how to integrate USAID and host country regulatory requirements related to environment, pesticides, and food safety with market-based standards and management systems throughout the project life cycle. It is our expectation that participants will acquire the skills required to ensure improved environmental performance of agrifood activities within their respective USAID Missions.



Course Objectives:

- Establish effective intervention techniques for your involvement throughout the project life cycle
- Integrate compliance and conformance along the value chain
- Create a peer network
- Improve awareness of available resources

Day One Outcome:

- Integration of USAID pesticide procedures throughout the project life cycle

- Recognition and documentation of compliance with regulatory and market based pesticide and food safety management system criteria
